


Some websites might appear blank or might not display correctly in Windows Internet Explorer 9 (or other versions). For example, portions of a webpage might be missing, information in a table might be in the wrong locations, or colors and text might be incorrect. Some web pages might not display at all.

If a portion of the webpage is blank or doesn't display correctly, try one or more of the following procedures:

### **To turn on Compatibility View**

1. Open Internet Explorer.
2. Click the Compatibility View button  on the Address bar.
3. Under the Tools menu at the upper right corner of the window, click on "Compatibility View Settings."
4. Add [alpinequilters.org](http://alpinequilters.org) in the "Add this website" window. Click on the "Add" button, then click "Close."
